Reference: Energy Imbalance Market Entity Agreement

On June 29, 2022, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed an Energy Imbalance Market Entity Agreement (EIM Agreement) with Avangrid Renewables, LLC (Avangrid Renewables).<sup>1</sup> CAISO states that the EIM Agreement sets forth the legal obligations and operational rules that will govern Avangrid Renewables' participation in CAISO's Western Energy Imbalance Market. Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 (2021), the EIM Agreement is accepted for filing, effective August 29, 2022, as requested.

The filing was publicly noticed, with interventions and protests due on or before July 20, 2022. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2021)), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. Granting a late intervention at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties. No protests or adverse comments were filed.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in

the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2021).
