Policy Initiatives Update

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Day-Market Enhancements (DAME) – Upcoming Milestones

- The DAME Tariff process is underway
 - July 11th Revised draft tariff language posted
 - July 25th Comments due
 - July 27th Stakeholder meeting
- Final version of the DAME tariff, informed by stakeholder comments, will be posted in mid-August prior to FERC filing.
- Planning and preparations for DAME implementation working groups underway and expected to begin in 2024

Extended-Day Ahead Market (EDAM) - Tariff Development Activities

- Second revised draft EDAM tariff
 - Published on June 8th
 - Comments received on July 6th
 - Stakeholder meeting scheduled for July 26th
- Final version of the EDAM tariff, informed by stakeholder comments, will be posted in mid-August prior to FERC filing.
- FERC filing is targeted for mid-August as a joint, single, filing of the DAME and EDAM tariffs, seeking a December 2023 decision.
 - Joint filing recognizes interdependency of the designs

EDAM - Implementation Activities

- Continued internal development of business requirements to implement EDAM design.
 - Started engagement with vendors to support timely implementation.
 - Publication of the business requirements in July 2023.
- Commenced onboarding activities with PacifiCorp.
 - Engagement between teams on implementation activities.
 - Review of business requirements to facilitate engagement with vendors.

ISO EDAM BAA Participation Rules - Activities

- The initiative evaluates certain rules and processes detailing how the ISO participates in the EDAM.
- These rules include consideration of:
 - Allocation of revenues and surcharges which are settled with entities with the ISO BAA
 - Consideration of a net EDAM export transfer constraint for the ISO BAA
 - Tools and processes for supporting the ISO passing the resource sufficiency evaluation
- Track 1 of the initiative is slated for presentation to the ISO Board of Governors in <u>September</u>.
 - Proposes elements needed to support EDAM go-live

Transmission Service & Market Scheduling Priorities – Activities

- Continued engagement in stakeholder tariff development activities.
- Phase 1 tariff filing focuses on the process for requesting available transfer capability (ATC) in monthly and daily horizons for establishing wheeling through scheduling priority.
 - FERC filing targeted for the end of July.
- Phase 2 tariff development will focus on the process for studying requests for ATC of 1-year or longer and pursuing a transmission upgrade.
 - Publication of draft tariff on July 14 for stakeholder review.
 - Target FERC filing by January 2024.



Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Accounting Working Groups

- The ISO committed to continued active discussions and evaluating opportunities to evolve the GHG accounting design.
- Recognition of diverse and evolving GHG regulatory frameworks around the West.
- Initiating a series of stakeholder working groups in August to discuss ideas, perspectives and proposals for evolving the GHG accounting framework.

GHG Working Groups

- Topics of discussion include:
 - Review and common understanding of current design
 - Leakage, resource shuffling, secondary dispatch
 - GHG accounting reporting
 - Different regulatory frameworks in the West
- The working group discussion will inform the scope of a formal GHG policy initiative to evaluate key elements and recommendations emerging from the working groups.

Price Formation Enhancements

- Weekly Phase I working groups begin in August, continue through October
 - Topics: Scarcity
 pricing/market power
 mitigation, fast-start pricing
 analysis
 - Deliverable: Working Group
 Action Plan
- Straw proposal and faststart pricing analysis by end of 2023 (tentative)
