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

# Extended Day Ahead Market (EDAM) & Day Ahead Market Enhancements (DAME)

- EDAM tariff is fully approved and supporting implementation activities for launch in 2026.
- October 15: filed revised tariff provisions with FERC to support inter-scheduling coordinator trades in WEIM and EDAM.
- In July, the ISO held a DAME implementation stakeholder meeting to share the testing timeline, outline the testing approach, and set clear expectations for communication and engagement with stakeholders.
  - This meeting preceded the ISO's commitment to convene implementation working groups to test and refine specific "tunable parameters."
  - Stakeholders submitted comments on September 4, and the ISO is still reviewing the feedback.

# WEIM Resource Sufficiency Evaluation Enhancements (RSEE)

- Planned 2024 kick-off for Resource Sufficiency Evaluation Enhancements Phase 3
  - Scope informed by ongoing analysis of recent peak seasons and WEIM results
    - Metrics related to assistance energy transfers to help inform whether it is working well as-is, or whether we should explore any modifications
    - Performance of BAs passing the test including the uncertainty requirement, and sensitivities around today's 1% de minimis standard
  - Will start by presenting analysis and requesting stakeholder input on problem statements
- Proposed Decisional Classification: Joint Authority

#### Price Formation Enhancements Initiative

- On September 5, the ISO published a Discussion Paper outlining the next steps for scarcity pricing, BAA-level market power mitigation, and fast-start pricing.
  - The Price Formation Enhancements initiative has now entered Phase 2, moving all three topics into the policy design stage where the focus shifts toward developing detailed proposals.
  - The development of fast-start pricing will continue on a separate but parallel track, which aims to sustain momentum for all three topics while recognizing the unique complexities of fast-start pricing.
  - Working groups will begin November 2024.
- Proposed Decisional Classification: Joint Authority

### Greenhouse Gas Coordination (GHG) working group

- GHG accounting for state policies without a price on carbon emissions
  - Moving forward to design policy on an out-of-market GHG "accounting and reporting" approach, introduced and supported by stakeholders
  - Issue paper to be published this November and continue design discussions in upcoming working groups
- GHG information and metrics
  - Stakeholders requested additional GHG metrics and information to help support compliance with different state, local, and corporate programs
    - The ISO started publishing average GHG emissions rate monthly and annual reports
    - Additional metrics reports will become available through the accounting and reporting approach
    - Finalizing GHG metrics that will be monitored with EDAM launch
- Continued review of GHG design in the WEIM and EDAM
- Proposed Decisional Classification: Joint Authority

### Gas Resource Management Initiative

- Planned publication of Issue Paper in Q4 2024
  - Detailed discussion of prior policy development efforts that have resulted in our existing rules around gas resource market participation
  - Discussion of working group problem statements in context of potential design enhancements
- Proposed Decisional Classification: Joint Authority

### Congestion Revenue Rights (CRRs)

- ISO has kicked off a policy initiative to enhance the Congestion Revenue Rights (CRR) market.
- As part of the 2018 reforms designed to resolve observed inefficiencies with the CRR auction, the ISO committed to:
  - assess the impacts of the proposals and
  - consider more comprehensive changes to the CRR allocation and auction design.
- Proposed Decisional Classification: TBD

# Transmission Services and Market Scheduling Priorities (TSMSP)

- Wheeling through priority automated systems implemented seamlessly in April to support establishment of wheeling through priority for June 1, 2024 and beyond.
  - Supporting establishment of monthly and daily wheeling through priority.
- On July 8, FERC granted our petition for a limited waiver of the tariff provisions for the resale of wheeling through priority filed in April.
  - FERC waiver is through December 17, 2024.
  - Implementation is on track to meet this date.
- Transmission Services and Market Scheduling Priorities phase 2, focused on the study and expansion process for establishing long-term wheel through priority, is being evaluated in light of Order No. 2023 interconnection process enhancements and FERC guidance.

### Resource Adequacy (RA) policy development

The ISO will host a November 18<sup>th</sup> policy meeting to review the recently released Issue Paper and November 19<sup>th</sup> modeling meeting to review updated modeling results. The Issue Paper has three Tracks:

#### Track 1: Modeling & Default Standards

- Loss of load expectation modeling
- · Default planning reserve margin and default counting
- UCAP for default counting, in collaboration with the CPUC and other local regulatory authorities
- · Incorporating ambient derates due to temperature

#### Track 2: Outage and Substitution & Availability and Performance Incentives

- Updating the ISO's outage and substitution processes
- · Reforming availability and performance incentives

#### Track 3: Backstop Reform

- Increase the ISO's visibility into available backstop capacity
- · Increase transparency to stakeholders on backstop decision making
- Updating the current backstop product
- Longer-term solutions for the ISO BAA around curing deficiencies and assigning costs related to the EDAM resource sufficiency evaluation
