

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Public Advocates Office Recommendations

- 1. The proposed joint authority model should not be approved and the current delegation of authority model should remain.
- 2. The EIM Governing Body should clarify the expertise that it needs beyond the outside expertise that the DMM and MSC already provide.
- 3. The Public Interest Group representative should be a voting member.
- 4. The EIM Governing Body's membership should be representative and reflect the diverse characteristics of the EIM participants, e.g., rural, urban, coastal and inland areas, investor-owned and publicly-owned utilities, ratepayer and environmental advocates, etc.
- 5. The EIM Governing Body should clarify why the EIM Governing Body needs access to DMM and MSC market data and needs joint authority over approval of MSC members.
