I hereby submit my name in nomination for the Participating Transmission Owners (PTO) sector liaison for the Western Energy Imbalance Market (EIM) Regional Issues Forum (RIF). As you are aware, SCE is one of the largest PTOs and market participants in California and has been and remains an active participant in CAISO and EIM forums. In addition to activity in California markets, SCE is interested in advancing a reliable clean energy future and helping to find feasible and equitable ways of doing that, including through regional cooperation. Our participation in the RIF would help further those goals for the region.

I am currently the CAISO advocate for SCE and have worked for SCE in the power procurement and resource adequacy (RA) space for over 15 years. As a lawyer for SCE's renewable and alternative power group, I drafted and negotiated power and RA contracts, ran solicitations for power products, and presented in public forums on the SCE RFO process and on rooftop solar. I was part of the team that negotiated our first out of state wind project, a nearly 900 MW facility located in Oregon. That experience gave me exposure to power authorities outside of California. I also worked on the early stages of the Hoover Dam Contract, another venture that gave me experience dealing with multiple stakeholders from multiple jurisdictions across the West. After the law department, I spent several years advocating at the CPUC for our procurement and reliability efforts. For the past 18 months, I have been following CAISO and EIM matters specifically, including CAISO market matters, regionalization, and CPUC cross-over matters.

Given the above, I believe SCE's participation on the forum would be beneficial. I hope you will consider and accept my nomination as liaison.
