Regional Issues Forum Public Interest Group and Consumer Advocate Request for Sector Representative

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The Operating Guidelines for the Regional Issues Forum provide a framework to educate and address stakeholder issues related to EIM.

- Provide a forum for discussion
- Solicit input and participation from sectors on topics and content of forums
- May express common position to EIM Governing Body
- Communicate results of RIF meetings to EIM Governing Body
- Each sector shall select two Liaisons

The Regional Issues Forum consists of self-selected representatives from stakeholder sectors

- Membership of the Regional Issues Forum consists of two Liaisons from each of the following sectors:
 - Transmission Owning Utilities
 - Independent Generators and Independent Marketers
 - Publicly Owned Utilities
 - Neighboring Adjacent Balancing Authority Areas
 - Public Interest Groups and Consumer Advocates

The Public Interest Groups and Consumer Advocates sector seeks to nominate and select a new Liaison.

- Each sector is responsible for selecting two liaisons to serve on the Regional Issues forum.
- Public Interest Groups and Consumer Advocates definition:
 - *Organizations that represent the public interest or end-use customers*
