On July 24, 2020, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed a revised Energy Imbalance Market (EIM) Entity Agreement with the Balancing Authority of Northern California (BANC). The revisions restate the legal obligations and operational rules for the second phase of BANC's participation in the EIM. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted, and the revised EIM Entity Agreement is accepted for filing, effective March 25, 2021, as requested.

This filing was noticed on July 24, 2020, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before August 14, 2020. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
