


Economic benefits total \$369.36 million in Q1 2025




Gross economic benefits driven by:

Transfer volumes remained high in Q1 2025










Expansion of the western energy imbalance market has unlocked increasing volumes of economic transfers




Real-time prices in the western energy imbalance market were moderate and much lower than 2024
