

Selection Process for EIM Governing Body members

- Terms for two members of the EIM Governing Body, Carl Linvill and Robert Kondziolka, end on June 30
- Governing Body members are nominated by an EIM Nominating Committee comprised of stakeholder representatives, subject to approval by the EIM Governing Body
- The EIM Nominating Committee began the process of identifying potential candidates for each open seat in December 2020
- Robert Kondziolka, whose term is expiring, expressed a desire to be nominated for a new term

Selection and approval process

- Member Kondziolka had expressed a desire to be nominated for a new term
- After deliberations, the EIM Nominating Committee reached a consensus and has decided to re-nominate Member Kondziolka without interviewing other candidates
- With the assistance from the executive search firm, the committee identified qualified candidates for the open seat
- The committee conducted interviews, deliberated, conducted outreach to their respective sectors, and reached a consensus to submit for consideration
