### Selection Policy for the EIM Governing Body

- A seat on the EIM Governing Body for a 3-year term ending June 30, 2021 was vacated effective August 27, 2019.
- The Selection Policy for the EIM Governing Body provides the process for filling a vacancy.
- The selection policy provides that members of the EIM Governing Body be selected by a Nominating Committee comprised of stakeholder representatives, subject to approval by the EIM Governing Body





### Approval of slate of nominees

- Pursuant to the Charter for EIM Governance, if a vacancy occurs and more than eighteen months remain of the term of the departing member, a replacement member shall be selected to fill the vacancy
- Pursuant to the Selection Policy for the EIM Governing Body, the EIM Nominating Committee's final slate is subject to approval by the EIM Governing Body
- A member selected as a replacement shall serve the unexpired term of his or her predecessor

- EIM Nominating Committee was consensus-driven in its deliberations, with the goal of identifying quality candidates to fill the vacant seat
