Dear Mr. Anders:

On November 25, 2015, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted a filing to comply with a Commission order issued on October 26, 2015, in this docket.¹ The October 26 Order conditionally accepted the CAISO's tariff revisions governing the Energy Imbalance Market (EIM) and directed CAISO to make a compliance filing revising Appendix C of its tariff to clarify that the marginal price of congestion in EIM locational marginal prices will reflect the shadow price of all binding transmission constraints. CAISO's tariff revisions are in satisfactory compliance with the October 26 Order, and are therefore accepted for filing, effective November 4, 2015, as requested.²

The filing was noticed on November 27, 2015, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before December 16, 2015. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is

governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filed documents; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
