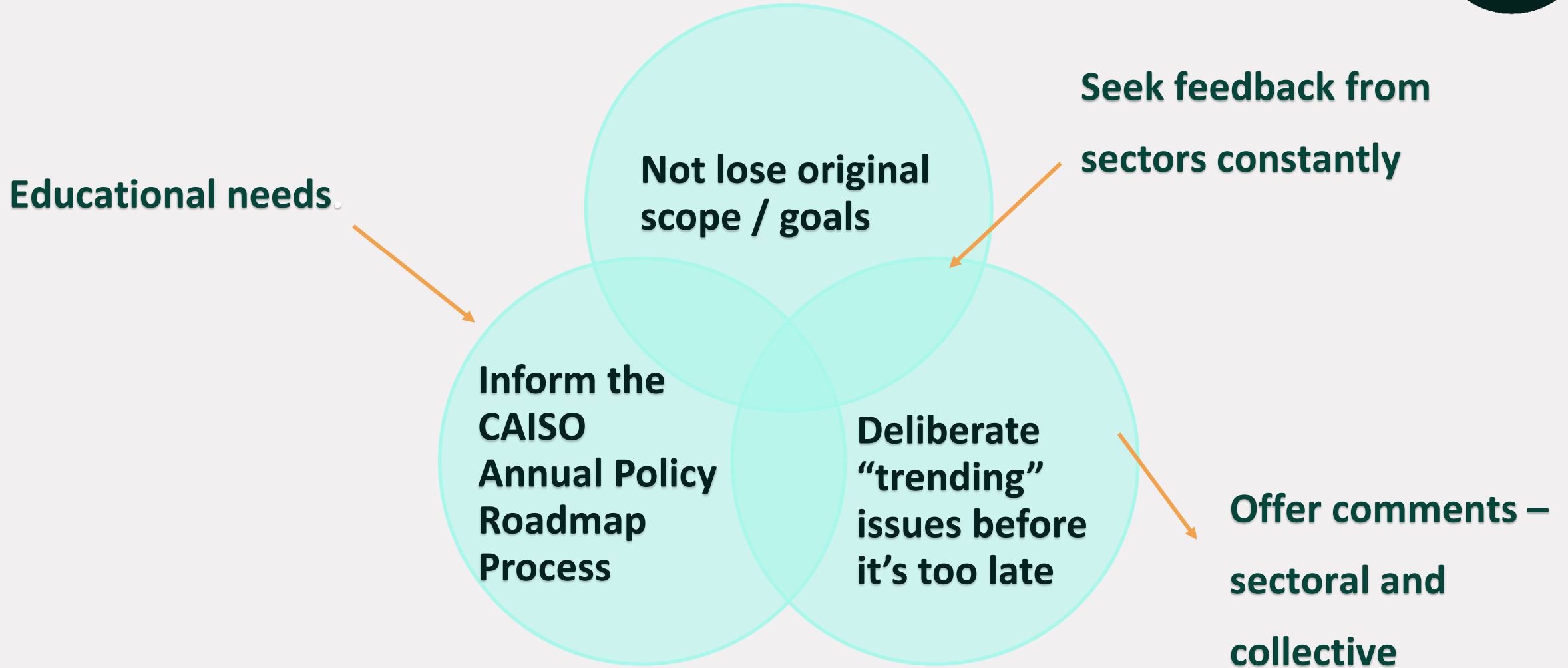


What did we get done in 2022?
